Crosstown Application

Because you are **NOT** a Georgia Tech student, you **MUST** complete these additional requirements to attend:

a. **Cross-Town Registration**

Download the Cross-Registration Application Form and submit to the applicable office.

If you are student at one of our eleven “Cross-Town” schools, then you can join AFROTC at Georgia Tech. Please refer to our website for a complete listing of all eligible colleges and universities. All cross-town students **MUST** register for AFROTC classes offered at Georgia Tech through the ARCHE Cross-Registration program. The Cross-Registration Application must be submitted directly to your home institution’s registrar office no later than **15 July (Fall) / 15 November (Spring)** unless your home school has an earlier deadline. The Cross-Registration Application must be completed on time or you will not be able to join AFROTC. Once your ARCHE application has been successfully submitted and processed, you will receive a GT ID number and instructions for submitting your medical forms.

b. **Georgia Tech Stamps Health Services Requirements**

In order to cross-register at Georgia Tech, you must upload the Georgia Tech Medical Entrance Form and Certificate of Immunization **directly to the Georgia Tech Stamps Health Services** once your ARCHE application has been processed. Failure to meet this requirement will result in a registration hold preventing you from being scheduled for AFROTC classes. c. **Georgia Tech Buzzcard**

Once your ARCHE application has been successfully submitted and processed and you have received a GT ID number, proceed to the Buzzcard Office and to receive your Buzzcard (see Enrollment Information Packet for location).

Do NOT send the ARCHE Cross-Registration Application nor GT Health Services Paperwork to the Detachment.

New Student Orientation (NSO) Day 1

Note: You must BRING the following documents with you to NSO (Day 1 of AFROTC):

1. State certified birth certificate with raised seal: ORIGINAL & COPY
2. Social Security card: ORIGINAL & COPY
3. Selective Service card: COPY males only
4. ACT/SAT scores COPY College-Board printout
5. College Transcripts: COPY can be unofficial, if applicable
6. *DD214, JROTC, CAP, Eagle Scout certificate COPY if applicable

Begin to gather items 1-6 now, but **do NOT send them** to the Detachment. These documents must be physically brought with you to NSO - Day 1. Originals will be validated and returned immediately. If you cannot obtain originals of those requiring an original, please inform us when submitting your NSE application.

** If you have prior military service, to include enrollment in at service academy, you must provide a copy of your DD Form 214. If you have been disenrolled from any officer candidate program (service academy, any ROTC program, OTS), you must provide your Form 785.*

Basic AFROTC Entrance Requirements:

- Must be enrolled FULL-TIME at Georgia Tech or one of our eleven cross-town schools
- Must have at least 6 semesters if joining in the fall or 7 semesters if joining in the spring until earning your degree
- Must have at least a 2.0 college cumulative GPA (does not apply to incoming freshmen from high school)
- Must be age 18-39 at the time of graduation (18-29 for pilots, some restrictions apply)
- Must be within Air Force Accessions BMI / body fat standards to remain in the program
- Must hold U.S. citizenship by February of your AS 300 year (typically your junior year)

**This list is NOT all-inclusive; other entrance standards may apply*
